





1. What is Enteroguard?

Enteroguard is a unique concentrated formulation based on a blend of essential oils and amino acids developed for Poultry Healthy Services and intended for use in poultry production for increasing and supporting performance. It was formulated by a team of veterinarians and nutritionists to satisfy both veterinarian and farmer's needs. Today it is used in poultry diets to maximise performance and returns.

2. Why essential oils? Are they really working?

The value of essential oils as feed additives has been known for some time. One of the main active compounds in essential oils are Thymol (from Thyme), Eugenol (from Cinnamon) and Carvacrol (extracted from Oregano). The latest research on essential oils has focused on the antibacterial, antifungal, insecticidal, anticancer and antioxidant properties. The benefits of essential oils have been known and demonstrated for many years both in human and veterinary medicine, to aid maturation of the intestinal cells and development of intestinal tissues, for optimal nutrient absorption.

3. Why should we use Enteroguard?

Enteroguard represents the opportunity for poultry industry producers to improve performance using a natural approach.

Enteroquard offers functional benefits to poultry in terms of:

- · Enhancing animal growth performance, offering an alternative for AGP (Growth Promoters)
- Supports and improves the digestion and intake of nutrients, sustaining a balanced gut microflora
- Supports feed conversion and weight gain in periods of increased stress such as enteritis and coccidiosis.

4. How does Enteroguard work?

Enteroguard boosts gut health by increasing digestive enzymes, decreasing ammonia production and altering the metabolism of harmful bacteria.

5. In what situations can Enteroguard be used?

- . To support feed intake during times of stress (transport, feed changing)
- In situations where there is a wet litter/poor litter quality
- In any situations where the animals are behind the performance targets
- During episodes of intestinal disturbances (e.g. enteritis, coccidiosis)

6. What is the purpose of Thyme Oil in Enteroguard?

THYMOL - Developed from the ajowan herb, has antiseptic qualities that help to fight gut infection while decreasing the risk of intestinal disturbances



7. How do you administer Enteroguard?

Enteroguard can be used for broilers, breeder and layers by dosing 200ml per 1,000ltr of drinking water for 3-5 days.

- Medicator Pump: Prepare a pre-solution of 200ml Enteroguard in 10ltr of water.
 The solution should be dosed by a medicator equipment to 1000ltr of drinking water at the dosing rate of 1%.
- Direct Dosing: Add directly to the drinking water system with dosing equipment at the ratio of 0.02% (e.g. with 200ml per 1000L of water)
- Water Header Tank: Add 200ml per 1000L water directly to the header tank and ensure homogenous mixing.
- For all species, we recommend 3 days of treatment.

8. What about the withdrawal time and human safety concerns?

Enteroguard has zero time withdrawal period and is safe for humans. Providing peace of mind for the farmer, the vet and the final consumer.

Essential Oils	Function
Thyme Oil	Stimulates feed intake, improves nutrient absorption, promotes gut health and repair.
Cinnamon Oil

Essential Amino Acids	Function
Threonine	Major component of the mucus lining in the gut wall.
Arginine	Supports blood vessel dilatation which improves nutrient absorption through the intestinal wall.
